

45 California Elementary Schools Received an African American Growth API of 785 or Higher in 2007

In 2007, 615 elementary schools received an African American Growth API. Their scores ranged from 484 to 882—a difference of almost 400 points. The mean African American API among these schools was about 684, compared with an average schoolwide API of about 725.

The 45 schools listed below received an African American Growth API in 2007 of 785 or higher, or at least 1.5 standard deviations¹ above the mean. They are listed in descending order based on their scores.

¹ A standard deviation indicates how much schools' African American Growth API scores in 2007 differed from the mean for all schools that received one. On average, about 6.7% of schools at each of the elementary, middle, and high school levels would be expected to receive a score that was 1.5 standard deviations above the mean.

² Schools with a "(C)" after their name are charter schools, while "(M)" indicates magnet schools, based on publicly available information.

³ Data in these columns come from California Department of Education CBEDS data files (SIF Enrollment by School, 2006-07). All other information comes from the 2007 Growth API data file (except 2003 African American Growth API, which comes from the 2003 file).

⁴ Based on the percent of students participating in free or reduced-price meals, as reported for API.
